

IDOT PHASE II INTERSTATE ENGINEERING CLASS A OVERLAY PATCHING SURVEY I-57 FROM HALSTED TO TRI-STATE/I-294

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CONTRACT: Illinois Department of Transportation PTB 195/Item 10 - Task Order 11

DAMA is involved in Task Orders for work along the Kennedy Expressway/I-90 and I-57 in Cook County.

The work includes the assessment of roadway surface conditions, development of Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) sequences using QDAT, shoulder reconstruction, roadway plans, drainage plans, and surveying of identified patch locations, bridge sealing needs, and drainage conditions along I-57. DAMA is required to coordinate plans and design work with IDOT staff and other consultants.

Surveying work for Class A patching covered about 8 miles of I-57 between Halsted and the Tri-State Tollway/I-294 in both directions. The survey of proposed and existing patching locations and field measurements of the Type, Size, and Location (TS&L) of identified distresses was conducted by the DAMA engineer staff and was coordinated with a moving lane closure with IDOT Maintenance assistance.
